Mr. Carlson:

Please accept this communication as a letter of interest in the Qualified School Construction Bond Program. Oregon School District's intent at this time would be to utilize \$1,000,000 of non-referendum debt to fix sections of roofs at Oregon Middle School and Oregon High School. These roof sections proposed have been evaluated by roofing consultants who have determined their condition as "very poor." In addition, the Oregon Pool which is owned and operated by the Oregon School District requires repairs of the exterior insulation and finish system (EIFS). Recently a large section of this building envelope system detached from the building. This event brought to our attention some significant issues with the entire twenty year old exterior building insulation system.

The district administration feels that these projects clearly fit within the "Green and Healthy Schools" and "Safe and Healthful Schools" categories. The Board of Education will be considering this request at their June 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting and possibly adopting a resolution at their July 13<sup>th</sup>, meeting.

The Oregon School District is committed to complying with the Davis Bacon prevailing wage requirements for the projects funded with the Qualified School Construction Bond Program.
