

Qualified School Construction Bonds (QSCB)

Eligibility Criteria

1. Funds can be used for:
 - a. New construction
 - b. Rehabilitation or repair of public school facilities
 - c. Acquisition of land
 - d. Acquisition of equipment (must be in the area of the school that is being constructed, rehabilitated, or repaired)

2. What DPI will look at when awarding funds:
 - a. Board approved resolution
 - b. Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM)
 - c. Early childhood, 4-year-old kindergarten
 - d. Safe and healthful schools
 - e. Ability to start the construction quickly and to create/retain jobs in the community
